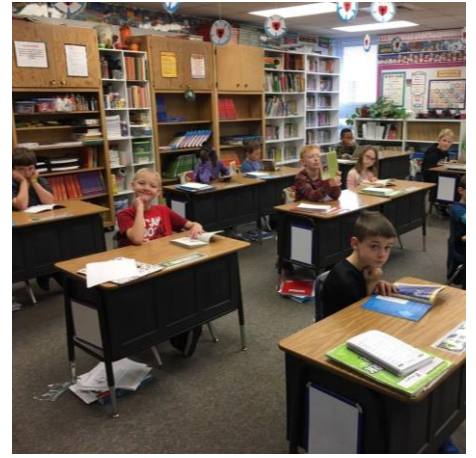
MISS BAUMANN'S CLASSROOM
